

CONSTRUCTION GENERAL LABORER - PIPE CREW

Job Summary:

The Construction Laborer – Pipe Crew will perform a wide range of physical labor tasks in support of workers on the construction site. This position involves several different manual tasks. All work is completed per the Foreman's direction.

Supervisory Responsibilities:

None.

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Hand shovels to help prepare ground trenches for water, sewer and utility lines. Could possibly include digging up existing lines on the job. May be required to hand shovel and rake as needed to perform groundwork.
- Will be required to work with underground utilities.
- May be required to assist in installing pipe into place when in the trench, connecting as needed and using the various tools and materials needed.
- May be trained to operate equipment as employee continues to show growth within his job abilities.
- Assists skilled workers as assigned. This may include jobs such as demolition, carrying lumber, or construction.
- Unloads materials that are delivered such as pipe, rock, etc., and distributes them to appropriate location as identified by Foreman, project plans, or specifications.
- Prepares layout area where construction will take place by properly measuring, marking, or recording openings or distances.
- Prepares tools and materials for skilled workers as requested by Project Foreman.
- Cleans and prepares specific areas of jobsite as assigned. This may include digging trenches; cleaning up rubble, debris, and trash; or removing hazardous materials.
- Operates a wide variety of hand and power tools.
- Directs traffic near, in, or around work zones.
- Motions equipment operator to assist with alignment, movement, or adjustment of machinery, equipment, or materials.
- Cleans jobsite at the end of the day, ensuring trash is properly disposed of and materials or equipment are properly stored.
- Participated in the daily toolbox topics for safety.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

Required Skills/Abilities:

- Ability to listen to, understand, and follow directions.
- Ability to use common sense to carry out instructions.
- Ability to remain flexible as specific assignments change.
- Ability to work with a variety of personalities.
- Ability to perform basic arithmetic as needed to count and take inventory.
- Ability to ask questions.

Physical Requirements:

- Must have physical strength, balance, hand-eye coordination, and stamina necessary to complete jobs in various areas.
- Must be able to stand, walk, kneel, bend as this is a position that is constantly in motion.
- Must be able to lift and carry up to 80 pounds and push and/or pull 50-pound loads at a time.
- Must be able to work in all weather conditions since the work is outside, this includes rain, snow, extreme hot and cold.
- Must be able to work some Saturdays.
