Job Summary:

The Surveyor position is responsible for the construction staking, verification of grade and other duties as required.

Supervisory Responsibilities:

- None

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Transports tools and other construction equipment to and from construction sites.
- Staking construction site for roadways, utilities, etc. as necessary.
- Ability to read and interpret blueprints.
- Ability to set up survey equipment to measure distance, elevations, and angles.
- Locate the vertical and horizontal control, right of ways, corners, boundaries, and the property lines.
- Learn and follow all safety rules and regulations.
- Assists in training less-experienced employees on the proper operations, servicing, and repair of equipment to help assist in furthering their knowledge of the equipment and its usage.
- When not operating surveying equipment, you will be required to assist other workers performing other duties which may include shoveling, raking, etc.
- Wear proper PPE (safety) when on site.

Required Skills/Abilities:

- Extensive knowledge of Trimble system.
- Ability to read building plans related to land grades.
- General knowledge of materials, methods, and tools used in the construction industry.
- Excellent mechanical and problem-solving skills.
- Ability to perform basic arithmetic as needed
- Ability to follow instructions.

Physical Requirements:

- Able to complete physically demanding work.
- Must have physical strength, balance, hand-eye coordination, and stamina necessary to complete jobs in various areas.
- Able to kneel, crouch, or crawl in awkward spaces to repair equipment.
- Must be able to work in all types of weather, including extremely hot and extremely cold temperatures.
- Must be able to work some Saturdays as needed.
